Information Note for Participants

Venue

The Regional Symposium on Sustainable Food Systems for Healthy Diets in Europe and Central Asia will be held in the Danubius Hotel Helia (1133 Budapest, Karpat utca 62-64)¹. The event will start at 8.30 hours on Monday, 4 December 2017, and will conclude at 16.30 hours on Tuesday, 5 December 2017.

Online registration

On-site check-in

Participants are requested to arrive at the venue at 8.30 hours on 4 December 2017 for the on-site check-in procedure. Supported participants will have the opportunity to check-in to the hotel on 3 December 2017 (Sunday).

Working languages

Simultaneous interpretation and symposium materials will be provided in English and Russian language.

Symposium materials

All symposium materials will be made available on the dedicated website of the symposium². As the symposium materials are available online, participants are encouraged to use personal lap-tops/tablets during the symposium (for which electrical outlets will be made available in the meeting room) in order to reduce the need for hard copy documents.

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Formalities for entry into Hungary

Passport holders of some countries outside the Schengen area require a visa to enter Hungary. Participants who require a visa to enter Hungary, and have indicated this during the online registration, will be issued an official invitation by the FAO Regional Office for Europe and Central Asia to support the applications for the entry visa.

Arrival and transportation to the city

The *Liszt Ferenc* International Airport (previously called "Budapest Ferihegy International Airport") is located 16 kilometres East-Southeast of the centre of Budapest, accessible by the Üllői road.

Depending on the traffic and mode of transportation it may take approximately 30-45 minutes to reach the hotel from the airport. Participants are expected to arrange their own round transfer between the airport and the hotel. The airport is serviced by the Airport Minibus Service and Public Taxis.

Airport Minibus Service (Airport Shuttle-Minibus):

The service takes passengers directly to the hotel but takes several passengers at a time, so may take longer than a taxi as other passengers may get dropped off along the way. Tickets can be bought at the Airport Minibus Service booths in several places at the airport (e.g: in the baggage claim hall or just outside security doors in the Arrival Hall). Airport Taxi:

Public Taxis are available just outside of airport arrivals terminals. Cost is approximately 25 to 30 EUR (28 to 34 USD) (7840 to 9400 Forint) per trip, depending on the traffic.

Public Transportation:

Bus Nr. 100E commutes between Terminal 2 and the Deak Ferenc ter metro station (metro line M1, M2 and M3). (Approx. journey time: 40-60 min). The price of the ticket is 900 HUF (around 3.4 USD). Exchange of foreign currency

Foreign currency may be exchanged at the airport or at exchange offices and banks in the city. Note that the exchange rates at the airport are less favourable and the commission about 20 percent higher than in the exchange offices/banks in the city. The approximate exchange rates at the exchange offices/banks in the city are: EUR 1 = HUF 309.5, and US\$ 1 = HUF 266 (as at 29 October 2017).

Hotel accommodation

Except for supported participants, the accommodation is to be booked and covered directly by the participants. A list of proposed hotels, with a location nearby the venue of the Symposium, can be found below. Please be

informed that there are no arrangements for special hotel prices and that no block reservations are made, therefore the FAO Regional Office cannot guarantee availability in these hotels.
